MAKE A SECRET GAUGE

Directions: Practice using the Secret Gauge with the safe and unsafe secrets scenarios.

MATERIALS:

- Paper plate
- Black marker
- Metal brad
- Green and red markers or crayons
- Black construction paper
- Scissors

HOW TO:

1. Provide a paper plate for your child to draw half of a circle. Color a quarter of the circle green and a quarter of the circle red.
2. Cut an arrow from the black construction paper and poke a small hole in the middle of the plate and at the bottom of the arrow.
3. Attach the arrow to the plate with the brad, inserting it through the hole in the arrow and the hole in the plate.
4. Use the black marker to write "Safe" at the bottom of the green quarter and "Unsafe" at the bottom of the red quarter. Write "Secret Gauge" on the paper plate.
