MAKE A SECRET GAUGE

Directions: Practice using the Secret Gauge with the safe and unsafe secrets scenarios.

MATERIALS:

- Paper plate
- Black marker
- Metal brad
- · Green and red markers or crayons
- · Black construction paper
- Scissors

HOW TO:

- 1. Provide a paper plate for your child to draw half of a circle. Color a quarter of the circle green and a quarter of the circle red.
- 2. Cut an arrow from the black construction paper and poke a small hole in the middle of the plate and at the bottom of the arrow.
- 3. Attach the arrow to the plate with the brad, inserting it through the hole in the arrow and the hole in the plate.
- 4. Use the black marker to write "Safe" at the bottom of the green quarter and "Unsafe" at the bottom of the red quarter. Write "Secret Gauge" on the paper plate.
